To maintain consistency all clubs will follow the

ATA FAILURE TO FIRE RULES

Section VII.D:

- 1. A contestant shall be allowed two (2) failures to fire in each 25 target event.
- 2. Whenever an allowable Failure to Fire occurs, the scorer shall mark a large legible F1/F2 on the score sheet in the space where that target is scored along with the score for that target.
- 3. After two (2) Failures to Fire occur, any subsequent Failure to Fire, for any reason, shall be ruled "LOST" and shall be scored accordingly.

What is **NOT** a Failure to Fire:

"No Picking Your Target": (Section VII.C.2) When a whole target appears promptly after a contestant's recognizable command and is within the legal limits of flight and the contestant voluntarily does not fire, the shot is ruled "LOST" (NOT Failure to Fire)

"Soft Loads Rule": (Section VII.C.7) When a shot is fired and no part of the wad or shot remains in the barrel and the target is missed the shot is ruled "LOST". However, when a shot is fired and the wad or shot remain in the barrel it shall be deemed a "Failure to Fire" and the "Failure to Fire" Rules apply.
